
2. It is about maximal torque (minimal requirement is 1000 Nm) and we want to have it in a bigger range of engine rpm because we want as efficient engine as possible and in that area fuel consumption is the lowest. There are manufactures that have a engine which can satisfy our needs. As example some engines can produce this in area from 1200 to 1600 rpm, some from 1200 to 1800 rpm and some from 1000 to 1500 rpm, etc.

Question:

3. IN ADDITION, A MAX ENGINE POWER OF 280 HP AT 2,600 rpm IS REQUIRED. PLEASE, EXPLANE WHY THIS EXACTLY TORQUE AND WHETHER THE REQUIREMENT IS MET BY ENGINE THAT ACHIEVE THE REQUIRED POWER AT LOWER TORQUE?

Answer:

3. There was a error in translation. We need maximum engine power in the area up to 2600 rpm.
Maximum engine power: ≤ 206 kW (280 hp) up to 2,600 rpm
So any engine that have max.power up to 206 kw in the area up to 2600 rpm can achieve our needs. Example: engine that have a maximum output of 200 kW at 1800 rpm and maximum torque of 1100 Nm in the area of 1200-1800 rpm have all requiments (maximum torque and maximum engine power).

Question:

5. In order to prove the financial reference, is it enough to submit as proof only three contracts in the total value of 300,000 euros, or is it necessary to submit a confirmation of the success of the contract or some other document?

Answer:

5. The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last 5 years from submission deadline.

- the tenderer has delivered supplies under at least three contracts with a budget of at least 300.000,00 EUR in field related to this contract (tanker trucks or waste collection trucks or similar) which were implemented in the course of the past 3 years up to the deadline for submission.

This means that the contract the tenderer refers to could have been started or completed at any time during the indicated period but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during that period, nor implemented during the entire period. Tenderers are allowed to refer either to projects completed within the reference period (although started earlier) or to projects not yet completed. In the first case the project will be considered in its whole if proper evidence of performance is provided (statement or certificate from the entity which awarded the contract, final acceptance). In case of projects still on-going only the portion satisfactorily completed during the reference period will be taken into consideration. This portion will have to be supported by documentary evidence (similarly to projects completed) also detailing its value.
